

Summer Procedures for Parents

Check in and drop off

- Only participants and staff will be allowed inside the Hailey Classroom
- Doors will be locked, please ring bell if staff is not waiting at door

Screening

- A staff member will greet you outside the classroom at arrival and administer screening questions about the health of youth and their household members and take temporal (forehead) temperature. Below is an example of the screening questions.
 - O Have you or anyone in your household tested positive for COVID 19 in the last 14 days?
 - o Do you or anyone in your household think you (or they) could have COVID 19?
 - O Do you, anyone in your household or anyone you have been in close contact with have these symptoms?
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Sore throat
 - Diarrhea
- Temporal (forehead) temperature must be below 100.4

Families who answer yes to any of these screening questions or have a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be allowed to attend camp

Physical distancing

- We have limited the number of participants to 8 youth and two adults
- We will all do our best to maintain 6 feet apart and avoid physical contact with one another
- Masks are required for all participants and adults indoors
- We will use a document camera for demonstrations
- Participants will have assigned seats and individual supplies to use at camp/workshops

Classroom Ventilation

- Doors and windows will be open while working inside
- Lunch always outside
- We will work and play outside as much as possible

Field trips

- We will visit the SVMoA Liberty Theater, SVMoA Museum and take walking field trips to parks around Hailey
- Masks are required for all youth and adults indoors
- Participants and adults will hand sanitize before and after each visit
- When walking or outdoors we will ask participants to stay approximately 6 feet away from each other

Cleaning

- Every break surfaces will be wiped down with disinfectant
- Staff will clean at the end of the day
- Outdoor toys will be for individual use only and checked in and out by staff and wiped down inbetween each use
- Students use their own set of art supplies for the week, if they need to share a supply it will be wiped down in-between each use

Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer as students enter classroom at beginning of day
- Hand sanitizer will be available on each table
- All must wash hands before food and after bathroom breaks
- Wash or sanitize hands when coming in from breaks
- No water fountains will be used. Participants will be required to bring their own filled water bottle each day
- No food or snacks will be provided

Refund Policy

- In the case of a participant being unable to attend camp based on check in questions or other symptoms compatible with COVID-19, parents can request a refund or credit for the pro-rated amount of their enrollment fee.
- If camp is canceled due to COVID-19 related illness, parents may choose to receive a refund, receive credit, or make a donation to SVMoA for the pro-rated amount of their enrollment fee.
- I understand that if my child or any other participant, staff member or instructor has tested positive for COVID-19 all participating families as well as health authorities will be notified.

As a parent and/or guardian of a child, I agree to abide by and follow Sun Valley Museum of Art protocols to help decrease the spread of virus transmission.
